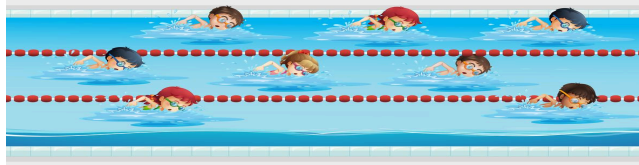

- Write the DAY as well as the DATE and the TIMES, so that we hold the needed space correctly.
- Write two separate checks; one for the fee based on invitees & one for the deposit.
- Make sure to sign and date the form at the bottom.

Architectural Committee: April Outdoor Reminders:

1. Remove weeds throughout landscaping.
2. Trim landscaping back from sidewalks.
3. Clear weeds in and around artificial turf.
4. Except for pick-up day your trash cans are always stored out of view.
5. Treat the lawn with weed killer (like Weed and Feed).
6. Check and repair yard drainage to prevent flooding.
7. Remove debris from drainage pipes at the gutter.
8. Clear debris, weeds, and moss from sidewalk and gutter cracks.
