The HCW Board of Directors will be holding on-line/virtual meetings until further notice and attendance will be through Zoom.

Just a reminder that we are in the midst of observing unprecedented conditions necessary to prevent the spread COVID-19 by adhering to "Stay at Home" orders, kids engaged in distance learning, parents working from home. In an effort to support our community, your Board is extending the **front yard seating and basketball hoops (for individual family use)** to remain in front areas to help everyone to stay connected – just at a distance of at least 6 feet. We hope this will help to remind each other how special High Country West community is! Please remember to keep your yard and seating/sports equipment tidy and neat. By the new deadline of August 30, 2020, all basketball hoops and unapproved seating must be moved from the front areas nightly. Thank You and Be Safe!

NEWS FOR POOL RESERVATIONS: Each household may reserve one 90-minute swim time every 7 days, in addition, each household may call daily to reserve unfilled swim slots. **If you need to cancel your reservation, call by 9 AM same day or sooner to cancel;** this allows another household to use your slot. You can then reschedule your once a week reservation for that week. Cancelations after 9 am or no-shows cannot be rescheduled. Are you running late for your reservation? If you will be later than 30 minutes late, call us ahead and let us know. After 30 minutes, all swim slots not filled will be given to call in households.

Reminder: Only members and the household that lives at the home may use the facilities at this time.

the world HCW's Community Clean-up, note what streets or other instructions apply **THURSDAY, OCTOBER 1ST, 2020** Items must be on the curb and will be picked up EARLY in the morning. It is best to have your items out by 7:30 a.m. Basically, the City will take just about anything as long as it is a not toxic or is not hazardous material. Some items for pickup include couches, beds, BBQs, it has even taken a spa (it had to be cut in half on the curb)... Also, palm fronds, but the fronds must be cut and packaged in small bundles. The clean-up is intended for items that are difficult to throw away and cannot be placed in the City's refuse collection containers.

SOME STREETS IN HCW WILL HAVE CURB SIDE PICKUP, OTHERS WILL HAVE TO BRING YOUR ITEMS TO THE CURB IN FRONT OF THE CLUBHOUSE (not the parking lot please, CURB only)!

The City of San Diego will only provide curbside pick-up for a "PORTION" of the streets in HCW. **We will know which streets are selected in mid-September and will publish the list in the OCTOBER NEWSLETTER.** Residents whose streets are "not" included in the city's clean-up map may bring your items to the curb in front of the Clubhouse for pickup by 7:30am that day. The HCW Clubhouse curb drop-off is for HCW Residents only!!!! LATE ITEMS placed on the curb after 7:30 MAY NOT be picked up. Please do not drop off items or place at curb later than 7:30 am on October 1st. Call Roland at the City of San Diego for more information at (858) 573-1227 about the clean-up.
