




Turtleback Elementary's Recycling Program

Architectural Committee: February Outdoor to Do List:

- 1. Take down all holiday lights and decorations.
- 2. Remove weeds throughout landscaping.
- 3. Trim landscaping back from sidewalks.
- 4. Clear weeds in and around artificial turf.
- 5. Except for pick-up day, ensure your trash cans are always stored out of view.
- 6. Treat the lawn with weed killer (like Weed and Feed).
- 7. Check and repair yard drainage to prevent flooding.
- 8. Remove debris from drainage pipes at the gutter.
- 9. Clear debris, weeds, and moss from sidewalk and gutter cracks.
- 10. Wash away mold from exterior stucco.
