Architectural Corner

The February Architectural meetings are scheduled for Wednesdays Feb 7th and 21st this month at the Clubhouse meeting room starting at 6:30 P.M. Please drop off any paperwork no later than the Friday before a meeting for your request to be reviewed.

Trash Cans: We have noticed trash containers are being stored where they are readily visible to community members passing by. Architectural Guidelines states "Containers must be stored in garage or behind privacy wall (not visible from street or from neighboring property) except during trash pick-up period." If you don't currently have a fence or gate to conceal your receptacles, they still must be stored completely out of site at all times when they are not at the curb on collection day.

Hedges/Shrubs/Bushes: For those residents who have shrubs/hedges/bushes in front areas, please trim back vegetation from sidewalk areas that overhang, both at the ground level and any upper vegetation that walkers need to duck under to get by. Along the sidewalk, shrubbery has a call out of a 3 foot height maximum. Please do your part in taking care of this needed trimming item.
