Emergency" app is online and also now available to download for your cell phone (this is NOT the same as the ALERT San Diego). The "SD Emergency" option from the website explains what this app can do. Some items the app covers are disaster planning, emergency preparedness, the posting of alerts happening such as red flag warnings, disaster info, maps, & recovery guidance.

ARE YOU NEW TO THE SAN DIEGO AREA? HAVE YOU MOVED HERE FROM ANOTHER PART OF SAN DIEGO?

San Diego County has an emergency system that will call your land line, cell phone, or send an email to you should there be an emergency (like fires) in your area. You must register your phones or email addresses for this service.

If you have moved here from another part of San Diego, you may want to re-register your phones to make sure they are listed in your new address location.
