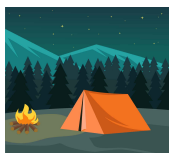
### President's Message

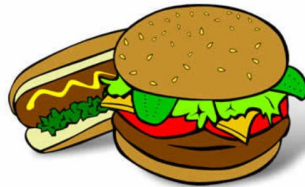
**Street Sweeping Friday June 16 PLEASE TRY AND PARK OFF STREET ON THIS DAY**
