### High Country West 2026 Annual Picnic SATURDAY JUNE 20 **\*\*Early Check In\*\***



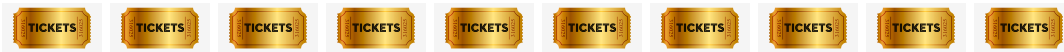

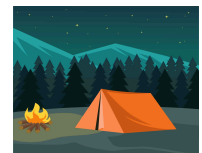

**June fun facts:** June is named after the Roman goddess Juno, who was the wife of Jupiter and the queen of the gods. June is the first month of summer in the Northern Hemisphere and the first month of winter in the Southern Hemisphere. June is the most popular month for weddings. June's birthstone is the pearl, symbolizing wealth and innocence. The famous English tennis tournament Wimbledon is played during June.

*June 14 is Flag Day (U.S.). Be sure to raise the flag! June 15 is Father's Day this year. June 19 is Juneteenth (also known as Freedom Day or Emancipation Day). On this day in 1865, Union General Gordon Granger read the Emancipation Proclamation aloud in Galveston, Texas, effectively liberating enslaved people in the state. June 20 is the summer solstice, which heralds the start of summer in the Northern Hemisphere. It's the day with the most hours of daylight. In the Southern Hemisphere, winter begins at this time.*

### Architectural Committee:

The Architectural Committee is composed of High Country West (HCW) resident volunteers. Each member donates their time to review and approve your architectural improvement and landscaping requests, identify and respond to potential violations of the Architectural Guidelines, and attend monthly meetings on the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30pm.

The Chairperson is selected by the Board of Directors and each committee member must be approved by the Board as well. The purpose of the Committee is to support homeowners in improving and maintaining their properties in line with the approved guidelines. The goal of the committee is to work with homeowners to improve their property to suit their vision, within the guidelines. If you receive a communication from the Committee, either in response to a plan to change your property or to address a possible shortcoming, we invite you to engage in a dialog to find an agreeable resolution. Each member on the committee understands HCW homeowners have busy lives with many commitments, just as committee members.
