How do you pay your monthly dues? Make it easy with multiple ways to pay thru our ACH System!

No checks are sent to the club, monies transfer from your account to HCW, and your account gets posted when the transfer is made! This is the easiest way for both the member and the office -through our online ACH portal system.

You can set up to *automatically make the payment* each month or- **NOTE**- you can also use this method to *pay monthly and you pick the day* (not autopay). Each month you log on to your account in the system and initiate the onetime payment the date you would like it paid. *We just need your email to get you started*. Paying by credit card through the ACH system is not recommended due to the charges you incur with using a credit card (listed as 3%). Debit card has a \$10.00 fee. It is great for an emergency but can be costly otherwise. If you have more questions, we are happy to help.
