CONSTRUCTION WILL BEGIN ON 12-02-19 FOR THE POOL AND DECK AREAS

We anticipate removing deck furniture a few days prior, followed by other deck items. Watch for updates, we will post information on this and when exactly will be the last day to access the pool.

When demolition begins the areas below will be closed during construction:

- All pools, spa, and deck areas
- Playground
- Basketball & pickleball court
- Grassy field

The meeting room will be open for indoor reservations only, tennis and raquetball access is being worked out with the contractor

The project is expected to take 2 to 3 months.
